

Baronial Polling Procedures

WHO IS ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE BARONIAL POLLING?

All paid members of the barony with their own membership number are eligible to participate. This includes those who are associate or family members, including minors.

Note that membership is based on the ZIP Code of the address on file with the Corporate Office. We make every effort to make sure that all current ZIP Codes in the barony are included, but you may not be eligible if your address on file with the Corporate Office is not inside the boundaries of the barony even if you have lived within the barony for some time, but simply have not notified Milpitas of your address change.

WHAT DO I HAVE TO DO TO VOTE BY PAPER BALLOT?

Paper ballots are still the default. As long as your paid membership and address are current, you and any associate and/or family members with their own membership numbers will automatically receive a paper ballot in the middle of January unless you have opted to vote electronically.

All you need to do is to complete that ballot indicating your preferences for baron and baroness by ranking them “1”, “2” and “3”. Note that you must assign a ranking to each of the three sets of candidates or your ballot may be considered incomplete and not tallied.

Once you have done that on the special colored ballot, place it in the provided postage paid envelope and mail it to Their Majesties. Note that

Their Majesties must receive your ballot on or before 1 February for it to be counted. Postmark date does not count so please allow for that when planning on when to return your ballots!

WHY SHOULD I VOTE ELECTRONICALLY?

There are several reasons why it is advantageous for the barony and for you to use the relatively recent electronic polling system which Hidden Mountain is using for the first time.

The three most important are the lower cost to the barony, the avoidance of the quirks and possible time delays of the postal system and the greater ease of use for the actual polling return.

Kingdom has calculated that each ballot generated, mailed and returned to Their Majesties costs the barony approximately two dollars. While we are a relatively small barony, across the entirety of the baronial polling that still comes out to a fairly significant amount of money.

And by using the electronic polling system you have until 1 February to fill in your ballot and actually send it to Their Majesties, avoiding the possibility that a delay in the postal system would cause your ballot to arrive late and so not be counted.

HOW DO I VOTE ELECTRONICALLY?

Access to the baronial polling will be through the Atlantian polling system at polling.atlantia.sca.org.

When you go to that address, you will see one of two splash pages. If you see the badges for various kingdom and Society orders at the top of the page,

you will see a link lower on the page that allows you to go to the baronial polling page.

If you see the arms of the various baronies at the top of the page, you are at the baronial polling home page and can proceed to log in if you have an identity and password in the Atlantian Enterprise Login (AEL) system.

If you have recently taught or taken classes at the University of Atlantia or are a member of the Orders of the Laurel, Pearl, Pelican, Golden Dolphin, etc., you will have a login ID and password. If you do not recall what they are, you can find them out by choosing the links for recalling the user name and/or password.

If you do not have an ID and password, then you will need to request one. (Note that you may have to create AEL logins for children who are members, since a majority of minors do NOT have enterprise logins.) You can do that by simply clicking on the Request an Account link and filling in the information requested on the screen that appears. (It would be a good idea to request an Account at least a couple of days before the deadline for electing to use the electronic ballot as we anticipate that the system managers may be a bit busy at that point!)

Once you have an AEL account (whether one you had for university or an order or one you have just been assigned), go to polling.atlantia.sca.org, go to the baronial pollings log in. If you get an error message, that means that your ID is not properly linked to your paid membership. Fill in the information requested and the system managers will update your entry to link your membership and notify you that you have been verified. (If it goes more than two days and you have not been notified, contact Alisoun at silverdragon@charleston.net so she can check on your status!).

Once your membership has been verified, you can log in and you will see several menu options on the left side of the screen. Choose the option for “Baronial Ballot Type”. If you have not yet selected that option, it will show a link that reads “Paper” as that is the default ballot type currently. If you click on that link, it will bring up a pop-up screen with information on your membership in the polling system. The very first item is “Opt-in”. If you click on the field, it will bring up the two options for electronic and paper ballots. Click on Electronic Ballot and click the “Update Ballot Type” button at the bottom of the pop-up window. You can then log out from the system.

Once you have chosen to use the electronic ballot (on or before 8 January when that option goes away!), all you have to do when the balloting opens on 15 January, is to come back to the Baronial side of the ESP to fill out and send your polling.

Note that the home page has an option which can automatically send the members an email when the polling opens and a warning when the polling will close the next day, as well as a reminder until you have completed the polling. Those options may already be pre-selected. If they are not, it would be a good idea to select both the notification for the polling opening and that for the imminent closing of the polling just to remind you that you have not completed the polling.

It is our hope that this letter will serve as our formal intention to put forward our names for consideration as candidates as the next Baron and Baroness of your great Barony of Hidden Mountain.

As the time for Their Excellencies Roibeard and Cecilia to step down as the representatives of the Crown has approached, we have been encouraged by the populace to contemplate putting our names forward for consideration. While only into our third decade, we have been working together as a team for one third of those years, most of which we have been active within the Society. Following his example, we would hope to kindle in others the inspiration He first kindled in us.

When circumstances of mundane life conspired to bring us to Atlantia's fair shores five years ago, we quickly integrated into our new Barony and Canton, taking on the responsibilities of the Baronial officers of Herald and Chatelaine, as well as the Canton offices of Seneschal and Chatelaine. In these positions, we have worked tirelessly to increase the population within Your lands and have seen the number of active participants in our canton more than double.

As members of the populace of Hidden Mountain, we have participated in our Barony in a variety of ways. Lord Patris is primarily an artisan, crafting fine jewelry, site tokens, and award medallions in pewter and silver. He has earned both a Silver Nautilus for his pewter casting displays, as well as a coral branch for his work with pewter. His art is frequently done in service to the Society, which has been recognized at the Kingdom

level with an Undine as well as with an Opal. Lady Slaine is also a talented artisan with diverse interests which include basketry, metal working, and baking, for which she earned her Coral Branch. Our joint service to the Barony of Hidden Mountain has been recognized with a Sable Mountain, and our service to our western neighbors in the Barony of Nottingham Coill was recognized with a Coill's Hydra. While neither of us participates in Armored Combat directly, we support our fighters through photography of their deeds and ensuring that they stay hydrated. Both of us are authorized in heavy rapier, for which Lady Slaine has been recognized with a Crimson Cloud. We have also worked to supply new rapier fighters with loaner armor and have prepared them to get authorized. We are both warranted archery marshals and Lord Patris has served as the archery marshall in charge at several events, both within and beyond the borders of our Barony.

As for the factors that contributed to our decision to put forward our names for your consideration, we would share them with you now. While many of the contributing factors in our deliberations are purely mundane and logistical in nature, our primary motivations for seeking to serve as landed baronage are to increase the growth, harmony, and commitment within the Barony of Hidden Mountain.

Growth

Growth has been one of our primary goals for the last several years, and we are only just beginning to reap the benefits of our hard work. We believe that as landed Baronage, we can not only continue these efforts but improve upon them. Through continuing to demonstrate the many talents and skills of our members in local venues as well as by expanding access to fighter practices and arts workshops, we hope to recruit the next generation of eager and enthusiastic subjects of Atlantia.

Harmony

Due to the large geographic area that comprises Hidden Mountain, it is only natural that strong bonds of comradery will form between those members who are located most closely to one another. Unfortunately, it has been our observation that while Canton identity is strong, our Baronial identity has suffered. We would seek to continue the good work that Roibeard and Cecilia have continued in strengthening our baronial identity. We would accomplish this through the forging of stronger Inter-Canton bonds, through increased coordination at events, and greater cooperation at a Baronial level. We wish for all who live in this beautiful Barony to be united and proud of the good works we can accomplish together. To this end, we will also encourage the Populace to travel with us throughout the Kingdom and beyond, that the entirety of the Known World will know the strength of Atlantian arms, the wit of Atlantian scholars, and the wondrous acts of service done by those who take pride in calling themselves an Atlantian.



Commitment

It seems like it should go without saying, but we believe that the next baronage should continue in the example set forth by Their Excellencies and have a firm commitment to all aspects of the barony. After consulting with landed baronages past and present whom we hold in great confidence, we understand that serving as the Crown's regional representatives will be a significant commitment of our own personal resources; not only of time and money, but of self, of sleep, and even sanity. In these areas, we are fortunate to be blessed with a light burden, leaving us with an abundance to share with our barony. We are also not so foolish as to think that we can do everything ourselves, and as such, we have a strong contingent of people in whom we can trust to support us whenever the need should arise.

We intend on taking an active part each month in our baronial meetings, and we would encourage the Populace to do so as well. We hope to serve as an example of how the Barony is stronger when we all work together. We intend that there will be no task too small, or distance too far, should we be chosen as Baronage. We hope that Your

Majesties and populace of Hidden Mountain would judge us not on mere words, but also think on the works we have already done.





Ingvar has been an active part of the Barony of Hidden Mountain since 1993, and an active member of the society since 1986. Ingvar's long service has included serving as Deputy Chronicler for the Incipient Stronghold of Ravens Cove (now Barony of Ravens Cove), Herald for the Incipient Stronghold of Ravens Cove, Baronial Minister of the List, Chatelaine for incipient canton if Iles des Diamants, Canton Exchequer and is currently serving as the Seneschal of the Barony of Hidden Mountain. Order of the Crimson Mountain, given for constant and exemplary contributions in the art of combat, either heavy, rapier, or cavalry (if it involves mounted combat).

Order of the Silver Mountain, given for constant and exemplary work in serving the needs of the Barony.

Order of the Azure Mountain, awarded for exemplary work in the arts and sciences while furthering the interest of the art form through teaching, displaying, and competition.
